Omnibus: Middle Ages & the Church Fathers

For High School students,

Grades 9 through 12

Omnibus is a Latin term meaning "all encompassing", and describes the classical approach to studying ancient history, theology and literature with applicable development of skills and application from logic and rhetoric. This course will cover a history, literature and theology from the fall of Rome to the Reformation. The omnibus practice provides the luxury of extended time periods for in-depth study in these fields in seamless combination, and the development of skills in composition/rhetoric, logic, and aesthetics. Studying the Great Books with a Christian worldview is not an imposing and impossible task, the classical methods employed make the undertaking doable and enjoyable.

Students enroll in the **Omnibus: Middle Ages & the Church Fathers**, a 4-hour class meeting 3 times per week, taught in an interactive seminar format. We will teach the Great Books in this course, including such titles as: Beowulf, Confessions, Ecclesiastical History of the English People, Eusebius: The Church History; On the Incarnation of Our Lord, Rule of St. Benedict in English, The Dragon and the Raven, The Fellowship of the Ring, The Hobbit, A Midsummer's Night Dream, and The Song of Roland, among others. Secondary literary resources are included to provide a more balanced course and a full literary exposure. Secondary resources include: The Canterbury Tales, The Divine Comedy – Inferno, The Bondage of the Will, History of the Kings of Britain, MacBeth, Sir Gawain, and the Green Knight, Henry V, King Richard III, and others.

Instructor is RCS Faculty member, Mrs. Patty Gregersem. B.Ed.

Texts used are Veritas Press', *Omnibus II* and other materials, included with tuition. Students will receive one High School credit each of Bible/Philosophy, Medieval World History, Medieval World Literature

#### Physics and Lab

#### For High School students, Grades 10 through 12

This Christ-centered high school physics course (Apologia) includes lab and covers matter and motion, mechanics, heat, light electricity and sound. Class will be taught classically, integrating discussion, group projects, laboratory, field trips, and writing/research. The course meets 2-hours, twice weekly, with a 1 hour lab meeting once weekly in the afternoon. Prerequisites: Algebra I. Corequisite: Algebra 2.

Primary text used is Wile's *Exploring Creation with Physics*, and other materials. Instructor is RCS Faculty member, Mr. Jon Nitta, B.Ed.. San Jose State Class size is limited to 18 students.
