Tuition for students starting after the beginning of the school year is prorated, based upon start date.

RCS collects tuition via an online tuition accounting and payment portal for families. Options for payment

include: Out of pocket expense, scholarship monies, K-12 tuition financing, or a combination.

To Register for 2019-2020

1. Pay Registration Fee,

The Registration Fee reserves your child's spot in the class and includes logo'd polo shirt, and K-8 student class supplies. It is a nonrefundable fee.

2. Sign Registration Agreement and Enrollment Documents/Acknowledgements.

All families enrolling at RCS must sign enrollment agreements, acknowledgement of billing and payments, acknowledgement of our school's mission and Christ-centered purpose, complete permissions by using the website link to our school's Sycamore platform, and identify a payment plan for tuition.

3. Submit student records documents, i.e. updated immunization record, birth certificate.
