PART-TIME SECONDARY HUMANITIES TEACHERS

Redeemer Christian School serves Christian families in a Christ-centered environment to equip students for a life of learning and service to honor God. We serve Christian parents who raise their children in Christ-centered instruction, and foster this partnership for their child's academic success.

DUTIES:

- Teaching positions entail following our established curriculum, providing classical Christian teaching, grading, using hands on learning, creating lesson plans, and using classical teaching tools, and relevant and subsequent measures of academic achievement.
- Inculcating Christian worldview among subject and lessons taught is vital.
- Secondary course openings are listed below, and include the following hours of weekly instruction:
 - Secondary classical literature (JH American classics, 5 hrs weekly),
 - Secondary history (JH Arizona History, 4 hrs weekly),
 - Secondary Bible (JH Genesis and Exodus, 4 hrs weekly),
 - JH Classical Writing and Grammar (3 hrs weekly),
 - HS Rhetoric (oration and writing, 4 hrs weekly),
 - Senior Thesis (HS Thesis, 2 hrs weekly), second semester
 - Intro to Poetry (2 hrs weekly), semester course
 - Intro to Debate (2 hrs weekly), semester course
 - Mythology and Fables (2 hrs weekly), semester course
 - HS Humanities Seminar (Ancient Classical Literature, Ancient History, Philosophy of the Ancient World/Bible, 13 hrs weekly in a.m.)
 - Upper Elementary physical education (3rd & 4th Gr P.E., 5th & 6th Gr P.E., 3 hrs weekly)
- Valid Arizona fingerprint clearance card and CPR card required.
- Supporting the development of the student's Christian character by teacher's influence in the classroom.
- Small class sizes: 1 to 15, teacher to student ratio.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Qualified applicants have, at minimum, a bachelor's degree and a Christian testimony, upstanding character, a love of children, and a love to teach and to inspire students.

- Strong Christian worldview, with the ability to connect the Scriptures and the character and handiwork of God into their subject area.
- Love of learning, an excitement about teaching classical literature and their iconic characters,
- Familiarity with classical Christian curriculum and methods, being teachable, and willingness to grow as a classical Christian educator.
- Strong collaborative skills with school team, working together in community.
